1. Goals and objectives of the discipline

The purpose of mastering the academic discipline Reproductive health consists in familiarizing and studying the pathological conditions that affect the reproductive health of women from puberty to menopause.

The objectives of the discipline are:

- Students' acquisition of knowledge about anatomical and physiological aspects of the features of the female body in different age periods.
- Students study the etiology, pathogenesis, clinic, diagnosis, treatment and prevention of major diseases of the reproductive system from puberty to menopause.
- Familiarization of students with methods of birth control in the modern world and the principles of prescribing menopausal hormone therapy for peri- and postmenopausal women.

2. Place of the discipline in the structure of EP HE:

Discipline *Reproductive health* belongs to the variable part of the disciplines in the specialty 31.05.01 "General Medicine".

2. Conduct a general and special gynecological examination.
3. Make a plan for laboratory and instrumental examination.
4. Interpret the results of laboratory and instrumental examination of the patient.
5. Make a differential diagnosis between diseases with similar clinical symptoms.
6. Diagnose urgent conditions in gynecological patients and provide emergency (emergency) and first aid, as well as determine further medical tactics in case of threatening conditions.

11. Guidelines for students on mastering the discipline "Reproductive health"

Training of students contributes to the development of their communication skills with a patient with taking into account the ethical and deontological features of pathology and patients.

Independent work — planned academic, educational, research, and research work of students performed during extracurricular hours on assignment and with the methodical guidance of the teacher, but without his direct participation (with partial direct participation of the teacher, who leaves the leading role for the work of students).

The student is required to attend classes, complete tasks of the head of the discipline, get acquainted with the recommended literature, etc. When certifying a student, the quality of work in the classroom, the level of preparation for independent activity in the chosen field, the quality of performing tasks of the discipline leader, and the ability to independently study educational material are evaluated.

At practical classes and lectures in the classrooms, the analysis is carried out relevant topics using multimedia technology (computer, projector).

Independent work during extracurricular hours can take place in the classrooms of the department, where students can study material based on presentations prepared by teachers of the department, as well as on computer tests.

Presentations on class topics can be recorded on CD-ROMs or flash cards for students to work independently on their home computer. Textbooks in electronic form on a number of topics studied are available on the pages of the department on the RUDN University Educational Portal, as well as on local resources of the RUDN University electronic library system.

As one of the forms of independent work, it is planned to prepare notes on various sections of the course, as well as present reports at the permanent scientific seminar of the department.

Extracurricular independent work includes: studying the material on a textbook, textbooks on paper and electronic media; preparing an abstract message on a selected topic; preparing for the implementation of control works and test tasks.

12. Fund of assessment funds for conducting intermediate certification of students in the discipline "Reproductive health"

To assess the level of mastering the educational material of the discipline "Reproductive health", which includes a list of competencies, indicating the stages of their formation, description of the indicators and criteria of assessment of competencies at different stages of their formation, the description of the scales of assessment, typical control tasks, or other materials needed for the assessment of knowledge, skills and (or) experience activities that characterize the stages of formation of competences in the process of development of educational programs, teaching materials, defining The procedures for assessing knowledge, skills and (or) experience of activities that characterize the stages of competence formation are developed in full and are available for students on the disciplines page in the RUDN University TUIS.
