Programme of Higher Education. Description.

General Characteristics

1.1. Objective (mission) of the Programme.

The Programme is designed to teach highly skilled specialists in Linguistics capable of taking into account scientific and research expertise and apply their knowledge and skills in their future professional activities. The objective of the Programme is to produce original scientific research contributing to the generation, expansion and development of the scientific knowledge as well as the formation and development of the students' competences in accordance with the requirements of the Standards of Higher Education of Peoples' Friendship University of Russia in the appropriate area.

1.2. Main Information.

The target educational level of the Programme is constituted by the preparation of researchers and faculty (post-graduate studies). It is a full time programme designed for three years. The graduates are taught to conduct scientific research in philology and to provide higher education in the appropriate area of knowledge.

1.3. Principles of the Programme Implementation.

The educational programme is implemented in English.

1.4. The Programme from the Perspective of Demand of the Labour Market.

The Programme is designed to teach highly skilled researchers and faculty as well as specialists capable of dealing with different types of texts. Those who complete their postgraduate studies within the framework of Programme Comparative-and-Historical, Typological and Contrastive Linguistics: Typology and Language Classification (45.06.01 Linguistics and Literature Studies) are recruited in the areas of education, translation, creating texts of different types, modern information technologies and other spheres. The graduates can pursue a career in Russian and foreign universities teaching theoretical subjects, employees of scientific laboratories, research institutes as well as be involved in the creation, translation, editing and expertise of different types of texts etc.

1.5. Entry Requirements.

A candidate wishing to follow the Programme is expected to have higher education (master's degree), usually in philology and linguistics, have scientific publications in Russian and/or foreign journals, or a synopsis of research in the selected area. The list of entry exams complies with the requirements for those wishing to follow Programme 45.06.01 Linguistics and Literature Studies and comprises examination on special discipline.

1.6. Graduate's Professional Activity:

The main educational programme designed for training highly skilled specialists (postgraduate studies) Comparative-and-Historical, Typological and Contrastive Linguistics: Typology and Language Classification (45.06.01 Linguistics and Literature Studies) was developed in accordance with the standard of higher education of Peoples' Friendship University of Russia.

1.6.1 Professional areas, where the Programme graduates will be involved, comprise philology, linguistics and contiguous domains of the humanities, both in theoretical and practical aspects.

1.6.2 Objects of professional activities of the Programme graduates are constituted by the languages (native and foreign) from theoretical, practical, functional, pragmatic, synchronic, diachronic, sociocultural, dialectological and comparative perspectives; various types of texts in their historical and theoretical aspects, created in different epochs, including those published in the media, in electronic communication, occurring in the forms of oral speech; verbal, written and multimodal (including electronic) interpersonal and mass communication in all spheres of human communication; linguistic technologies used in various information systems, specialized software and electronic resources in the humanitarian sphere.

1.6.3 Types of Professional Activity.

The Programme graduate is trained for scientific and research activities in the field of philolgy, linguistics as well as for university teaching.

1.6.4 Objectives of Professional Activity.

The graduate's professional activities comprise scientific research in the selected field of linguistics, working in professional research teams in the area of modern linguistics, preparation of scientific projects in linguistics, independent preparation of scientific publications in competitive Russian and foreign journals as well as teaching seminars and lectures at universities in the appropriate domains.

1.7. Competences to be Developed upon Completion of the Programme.

The graduate is expected to master the following universal competences, general professional competences and professional competences:
