1. EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMME GOAL (MISSION)

Principal professional educational program of higher education for the specialty 31.05.03 - Dentistry, developed and approved by PFUR on the basis of FSES of higher education for the specialty 31.05.03 "Dentistry", approved by the Order of the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of the Russian Federation from August 12, 2020 № 984. The educational program (EP) regulates the goals, expected results, content, conditions and technologies of the educational process implementation, quality assessment of the graduate education in this specialty.

The higher education programme in speciality 31.05.03 - Dentistry, which is implemented at the Medical Institute of the PFUR, aims at training qualified specialists who are in demand on the labor market.

The volume of the study programme is 300 credits. The volume of a full-time study programme in one academic year is 60 credits. The volume of EP in one academic year with an individual study plan is not more than 70 credits. The period of education on the EP: in full-time mode of study, including holidays provided after the state final attestation, regardless of the applied educational technologies, is 5 years.

2. EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMME RELEVANCE, SPECIFICITY, AND UNIQUENESS

Education on specialized programme "Dentistry" is allowed only in educational organisations of higher education. During implementation of the main educational programme on specialisation 31.05.03 - Dentistry various forms of e-learning are applied, distance learning technologies with application of modular principle are used. Besides, EP in specialty 31.05.03 - Dentistry is implemented in English language.
