1. OBJECTIVE OF THE TRAINING

The aim of the "Pedagogical Training" is to develop professional competencies through direct participation in pedagogical work, as well as the acquisition of professional competencies necessary to work in the professional sphere.

Main objectives: consolidation of knowledge and skills acquired in the process of studying the disciplines of the scientific specialty "Media communications and journalism"; formation of postgraduate students' motivation for pedagogical activity; acquisition of experience of independent pedagogical activity; acquisition of additional information on modern means and technologies of teaching and education in Higher School.

2. REQUIREMENTS TO PHD-STUDENTS ON FINISHING THE TRAINING

Pedagogical practice is aimed at mastering the competences of scientificmethodological and teaching-methodological work: skills of structuring and psychologically competent transformation of scientific knowledge into educational material, systematization of educational and training tasks; methods and techniques of compiling tasks, exercises, tests on various topics, oral and written presentation of subject material, a variety of educational technologies. As a result of pedagogical practice postgraduate student should have the following professional competences:

- ability to make independent motivated decisions in non-standard professional situations and readiness to bear the consequences for their consequences;
- the ability to implement and evaluate the educational process taking into account the specific educational context;
- the ability to reasonably select and effectively use modern educational technologies, methods and means of education, the purpose of ensuring the planned level of personal and professional development of the student in higher education programmes;
- ability to develop comprehensive methodological support of educational disciplines (modules) taking into account international best practices.

3. SCOPE OF THE TRAINING AND TYPES OF ACTIVITIES

The overall workload of the Pedagogical Training is <u>5</u> credits (180 academic hours).
