1. Aims and goals of the discipline:

The discipline is aimed to prepare highly qualified scientific and pedagogical professionals, to form and develop competences according to professional standards as well as to finalize an original scientific research thesis contributing to elaboration and development of knowledge in the linguistic sphere.

The main purpose of the course is to introduce PhD students to the typological methods and results in modern world linguistics. The discipline Typological Linguistics involves an integrative approach to the studies of the language classification, linguistic universals, structural types of languages and cross-language differences. The discipline includes studies based on systemic principle.

Course Aims:

determine methodological background and concepts of the comparative linguistics and typology; study of phonetic, morphological and syntax classification of languages; analyze language diversity from the point of view of the main concepts of systemic typology.

2. The rank of the discipline in the educational complex programme structure: Typological Linguistics is a discipline of the variative part of the Block-1 of the PhD studies of the specialization 45.06.01 «Linguistics and Literature Studies». Its main content concerns the elaboration and development of linguistic methodology on the basis of linguistic research and language description.

to compare the morphological structure of the word and sentence on the basis of common principles and terms;

Be skilled in: linguistic research methodology and modern linguistic scientific paradigm.
