1. Goals and objectives of the discipline: teaching Russian as a means of communication in the Russian-speaking environment and a way of getting to know Russia, its social, scientific, economic and cultural life.

The objectives of the course are to develop in students the following skills and abilities:

- mastery of socio-cultural competencies;

- the ability to communicate in the Russian language environment (day-to-day and cultural communication);

- the opportunity to join the Russian-speaking environment with a minimum level of Russian language proficiency.

2. Course in Higher Education Programme Structure:

The course «<u>Professional Russian Language</u> » refers to an optional part of block 1 of the curriculum.

- to express various feelings and emotions;

- give permission / prohibit; ask for permission, respond to a prohibition;
