1. DISCIPLINE (MODULE) GOAL

The objective of mastering the discipline «Russian as a foreign language» is increasing the initial level of foreign language proficiency achieved by students at the previous level of education (Master's degree) and further developing their linguistic and communicative competence necessary for professional communication, as well as for further self-education:

- improvement of communicative competence and formation of specific skills of receptive and productive speech activity as components of professional competence;
- improving the terminological base in the field of academic cooperation and scientific communication in English;
- language training, achieving a harmonious combination of professional skills, communicative competence and proficiency in scientific English at the level of solving professional problems.

2. REQUIREMENTS TO PHD-STUDENTS ON FINISHING THE COURSE

To know: the lexical minimum (of a general and terminological nature), the basic grammatical constructions of the Russian language; rules and principles of verbal implementation of intentions; language tools necessary for working with the text; the basics of Russian speech etiquette.

Be able to: use the vocabulary and grammatical constructions of the Russian language in speech; navigate and realize their communicative intentions, including in the educational and professional sphere of communication; carry out verbal communication in oral and written forms.

Possess: the skills of using vocabulary and basic grammar in speech. Russian language constructions; skills in applying modern communication technologies for academic and professional interaction; skills in listening to information contained in monologue or dialogic speech (including in the educational and professional sphere of communication).
