1. COURSE GOAL(s)

The discipline “Russian as a Foreign Language” is included in the specialty program “General Medicine” in the direction of 31.05.01 “General Medicine” and is studied in semesters 1 and 2 1 course. The discipline is implemented by the Department of Russian Language 5. The discipline consists of 3 sections and 9 topics and is aimed at studying educational and professional communication in Russian language.

The goal of the course “Russian as a foreign language” is to develop and improve professional and communicative competence of foreign students, including as the main components linguistic, subject, sociocultural, strategic, compensatory, discursive, speech-behavioural, infocommunication and other competencies, which ensures the effectiveness of educational and professional communication in Russian, readiness and ability to solve professional communicative tasks using the target language.
