1. OBJECTIVE OF THE DISCIPLINE

The main goal of the discipline “Russian language and culture of speech” is to provide a solid foundation in the Russian language and to impart an understanding of the cultural history of Russia in its global contexts, to acquaint students with the Russian language system for communication in the Russian speaking environment, as well as with the language of the speciality necessary for education at university.

The main objectives are:

- create an expression on a linguistic topic in oral and written form;
- evaluate the proposed statement on a linguistic topic;
- analyse the specifics of the use of language units in oral and written speech from the point of view of compliance with the norms and requirements of expressive speech;
- follow the language rules (orthoepical, lexical, grammatical, stylistic, orthographic, punctuation) in oral and written expressions;
- master text editing techniques (use lexical and grammatical synonymy, remove unnecessary repetition of words, inappropriate use of words and phrases);
- write down the content of the listened and read text in the form of a plan, Transmit the content of the listened and read text in the form of a plan, summary, abstract, report, paper, essay;
- use quotations appropriately and analyse the text from the point of view of content, structure, style and use of expressive means of language;
- prepare a review (oral and written) of an article, book, film, painting or musical work.
