1. PURPOSE (MISSION) OF THE EP HE

In modern conditions, the demand for specialists in various fields of international economic relations, including trade, is increasing. A specialist working in the field of international trade is subject to increased requirements both to his professional, intellectual, and general cultural level.

Training of professional personnel with a high level of competence in the field of international economic relations to work in large Russian and international companies, joint ventures.

Program provides an opportunity to obtain the future specialist in the field of international trade the necessary skills, abilities and competencies to ensure a highly competitive position in the modern labor market.

The purpose of the educational program is consistent with the target professional sphere. It takes into account the basic requirements, such as: academic abilities, general employment in the workplace and considers the disciplines studied and the practical knowledge of the specialist both from the point of view of socio-political and from the point of view of personal development.

The program is developed on the basis of the requirements of the national qualification system and takes into account the requirements of the European qualification system for universities.

2. RELEVANCE, SPECIFICITY, UNIQUENESS OF THE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM

The program has passed the procedure of International accreditation and is certified by the German agency FIBAA (Foundation for International Business Administration Accreditation).

The educational process within the framework of the master's program "International Trade" is provided by teachers of the leading departments of the Faculty of Economics: International Economic Relations, Foreign Language, Economic and Mathematical Modeling, Political Economy, Finance and Credit, Management, Marketing, Advertising. The proportion of teachers involved in this master's program who have a degree (doctor or candidate of sciences) is 100%.

The program consists of a balanced set of disciplines organized in a logical sequence: a block of disciplines aimed at studying by students the most important areas of the world economy that affect the development of international trade, a block of disciplines that give in-depth knowledge directly in the field of international trade and a block of elective disciplines that contribute to the student's obtaining detailed knowledge already in a specific area of international trade.

The program also includes disciplines, the knowledge of which becomes an integral part of communication in an international environment (Professional foreign language; Theory and practice of international business communication).

All disciplines of the program are interdisciplinary in nature. The program follows a results-based approach.

The knowledge gained as a result of mastering the master's program "International Trade" is applicable in any field of international business; will be in demand in the organization, management of foreign economic activity; carrying out trade operations of an international nature. The level of training in the previous program is sufficient for admission to postgraduate studies in specialties.

3. THE NEED OF THE LABOR MARKET FOR TRAINING PERSONNEL IN THE PROFILE OF THE EP HE

All disciplines, research practice and related competencies within the framework of the master's program "International Trade" correspond to the characteristics of the graduate's professional activity and meet the type of professional activity and meet the requirements of the employer.

The master's program "International Trade" strictly fits into the overall strategy of the university, since it is aimed at training highly qualified specialists in the field of international trade. International trade is the most important component of international economic relations, so the training of highly qualified specialists in this field is widely in demand not only in modern Russia, but also in foreign countries.

The knowledge gained as a result of mastering the master's program "International Trade" is applicable in any field of international business; will be in demand in the organization, management of foreign economic activity; carrying out trade operations of an international nature. The level of training in this program is sufficient for admission to postgraduate studies in specialties.

5. SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS FOR POTENTIAL APPLICANTS

Admission to the University for areas of training for training in master's programs is carried out on the basis of the results of a portfolio competition on the applications of citizens who have one of the documents of the state sample: bachelor's degree; specialist diploma; master's diploma.

Documents (application, resume, copy of passport, questionnaire of the partner university, etc.) from applicants for training in joint master's programs working on the basis of RUDN University Agreements with foreign partner universities undergo preliminary consideration. Joint commissions, consisting of representatives of RUDN University and partner universities, consider documents and resumes and decide on recommendations for admission.

Admission is conducted at the full-time department (budget and paid places) according to the results of the portfolio competition.

To enter the program it is necessary to have:
