1. COURSE GOALS

The discipline History of Religions in Russia is implemented by the Department of the History of Philosophy. The classification consists of 3 sections and 16 topics and is aimed at studying key aspects. The development of religious traditions of the Russian Federation in the context of the formation of traditional Russian spiritual and moral values and the all-Russian civic identity. The course is implemented on the basis of the basic principles of the state national policy of the Russian Federation, the foundations of traditional Russian spiritual and moral values and consists of three main sections and topics grouped according to them.

The study of religious traditions involves the acquisition of knowledge, skills and abilities necessary to understand the historical foundations of the formation and development, as well as the current state of religious traditions in the Russian Federation, their doctrinal, religious, cultural, value and legal characteristics related to the traditional spiritual and moral values of the Russian Federation, relations between the state and religions in the Russian Federation.
