1. THE COURSE GOALS

The goal of the course: CORPORATE SECURITY is to acquaint students with the main theoretical paradigms of corporate security; to form in students a holistic view of corporate security as the basis for the development of entrepreneurial activity (business), and the most important component of the national (socio-economic) security of modern Russian society.
