1. DISCIPLINE (MODULE) GOAL

The objective of mastering the discipline «Foreign language» (English) is to increase the basic level of proficiency in a foreign language achieved by students at the previous stage of education (master's degree) and to further develop their linguistic and communicative competence, necessary for professional communication as well as further self-education:

- improvement of communicative competence and formation of specific skills of receptive and productive speech activity as components of professional competence;
- Improvement of the terminology base in the field of academic cooperation and scientific communication in English;
- Language training, achieving a harmonious combination of professional skills, communicative competence and proficiency in scientific English at the level of solving professional tasks.

2. REQUIREMENTS TO PHD-STUDENTS ON FINISHING THE COURSE

To know: intercultural peculiarities of conducting scientific activity; rules of communicative behavior in situations of intercultural scientific and business communication; requirements for the design of scientific papers accepted in international practice; features of written translation of professional texts, as well as stylistic distinguishing features of foreign scientific literature.

Be able to: carry out oral communication in the monological and dialogical form of scientific orientation; write annotations to dissertations and articles, scientific articles, theses, reports, abstracts; read original literature in a foreign language in the relevant professional field; formalize information extracted from foreign sources in the form of translation, report, abstract, annotation; extract information from texts, listened to in situations of intercultural scientific and professional communication (report, lecture, interview, debate, etc.); use etiquette forms of scientific, professional and business communication.

Possess: processing a large amount of foreign language information in order to prepare an abstract; skills in writing papers in a foreign language for publication in foreign journals; communication skills for participating in scientific debates in a foreign language in their professional field; skills in delivering a scientific report on the problems of dissertation research.
