CONDITIONS AND REQUIREMENTS FOR MATERIALS FOR PUBLICATION

1. Papers and abstracts in Russian and English corresponding to the topic of the conference and approved by the editorial board will be accepted for publication. Papers should be original and have not been published elsewhere.
2. The volume including references, abstracts and keywords in Russian and English should not exceed:
 - 6 pages for the report;
 - 3 pages for the report thesis.
3. The text should be typed in a text editor Microsoft Word:
 - font – Times New Roman;
 - size – 12 pt;
 - line spacing – 1,0 pt;
 - indents – 2 cm on each side of the page;
 - no repeated spaces or unnecessary line breaks are allowed.

STRUCTURE OF THE REPORT AND REPORT THESIS

1. **Article title.** The title should fully reflect the subject and theme, as well as the main goal (question) set by the author.
2. **Author names.** When writing the authors, the last name should be indicated after the initials of the first and patronymic names (*P.S. Ivanov, S.I. Petrov, I.P. Sidorov*).
In materials in English, the full name should be written according to the foreign passport, or the same as in previously published in foreign journals.
3. **Affiliation.** The official FULL name of the institution (without abbreviations) should be given. In English submissions, give the OFFICIAL ENGLISH NAME of the institution. The name of the institution should be followed by a comma, followed by the name of the city or country.
If authors from different institutions have contributed to the manuscript, institution names and authors' names should be concatenated by adding uppercase letter indices before institution names and after the names of corresponding authors.
4. **Abstract.** The abstract should be structured: contain the main provisions of the materials; reflect the author's view of the problem discussed, taking into account the analyzed material and the results obtained; allow the reader to understand the uniqueness of the research - how it differs from similar works.
5. **Key words.** It is necessary to specify keywords - not more than 5, contributing to the indexing of the article in search engines.



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6. A full text should be divided into meaningful parts and contain an introduction, the main part and a conclusion.

Introduction - statement of the issue under consideration, relevance, a brief review of scientific, analytical literature on the topic, a clear statement of purpose of the work.

The main part should contain a description of the material, research methods, analysis and results, if necessary - is divided into sections with meaningful names.

The conclusion - the main outputs.

7. List of Sources. In the text, references to the sources listed should be given in square brackets (numbering according to the list).

In the list, references to sources are made in accordance with: Unified Style for Linguistics journals <https://www.eva.mpg.de/lingua/pdf/GenericStyleRules.pdf>

The list of sources is in alphabetical order without numbering.

If the source has a DOI, it is indicated at the end of the reference.

When referring to a part of a book or collection (article, chapter, section, etc.) in the list of sources, its beginning and end pages should necessarily be indicated.

A single list is used for the arrangement of the sources.

In the report in English all sources are given in the Latin alphabet and in alphabetical order. Transliteration is done according to the BSI standard (British Standards Institution): <https://transliteration.pro/bsi>
